Checklist

Durham Average Temperature 17 °C / 10 °C evening

To pack:

- A warm jacket with long shelves
- A sweater for daytime wear
- Gloves, scarves, thermal socks and inners, woollen cap
- Wear comfortable shoes (preferably waterproof) for long walks. Don't take too many pairs, as they will fill up your luggage. Also, carry a nice pair of floaters or sandals for evening walks.
- Shorts are good during the day; you may even wear them at the university and on other tours.
- A foldable umbrella or a raincoat
- Sunscreen if you have sensitive skin. The sun during summer can be strong
- A day bag: Keep your hands free and bring a backpack, cross-body bag or fanny pack to hold all your daily essentials like a water bottle, sunscreen, umbrella and all your souvenirs.
- Mobile phones and Wifi: The University will supply a local SIM card to each visitor with a minimum balance for emergencies. The residency and the campus will have reliable Wifi connections; the university will share the passwords after arrival. Make sure your mobile is unlocked for international calls and alternative SIM.
- Travel adaptor for mobile charging: The UK operates on plug type G. It has three rectangular pins in a triangle pattern, and it's good to note that the UK uses a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.
- Traditional clothes for social events
- While packing your bags, remember that your check-in baggage allowance should not be exceeded. Check your tickets for the permitted allowance. Travel as lightly as possible so you have some space to shop in the UK.







Useful Tips



Cobbled Streets

You will visit a lot areas in Durham and Edinburgh where the streets are cobbled. Flat, sensible shoes/trainers are best on these surfaces.

Pound Sterling

Carry sufficient pounds for your personal expenses. As a ballpark number, anything between 100 and 200 pounds should be enough to cover any personal expenses. Shopping in the UK and duty-free can be expensive. Please plan your money accordingly. Don't buy pounds from unauthorised agents or shops, as invalid notes are a risk.
